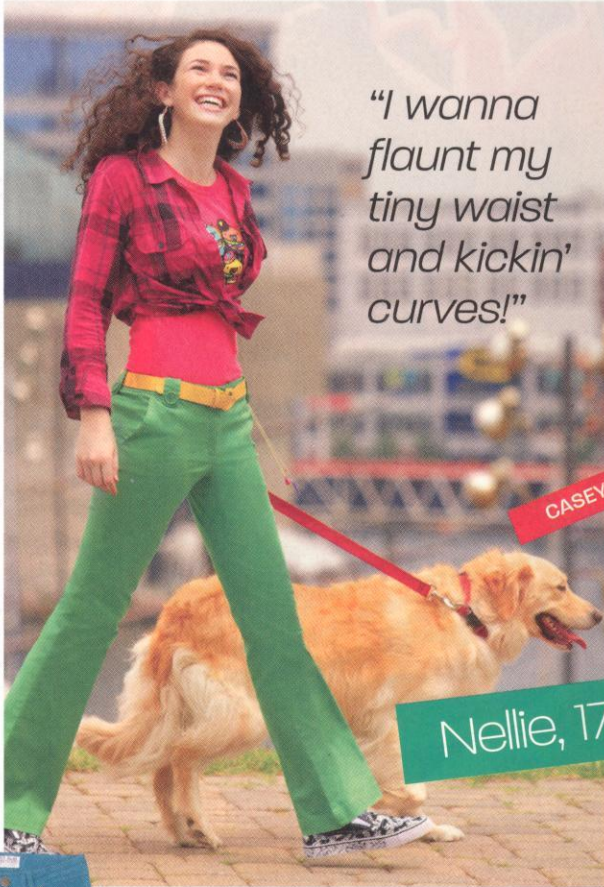


Ditch that denim—we got you covered
